Ivory Coast

Council Regulation (EU) No 25/2011

Her Majesty's Treasury issue this Notice in respect of the restrictive measures taken by the Council of the European Union against certain persons and entities in view of the situation in the Ivory Coast. This Notice draws attention to Council Regulation (EU) No 25/2011, provides guidance on certain aspects only of the Regulation and should be read alongside the Regulation.

Introduction

- On 15 November 2004 the United Nations Security Council adopted Resolution 1572 which introduced financial sanctions against persons designated by the UN Sanctions Committee as constituting a threat to the peace and national reconciliation process in the Ivory Coast.
- 2. Council Regulation (EC) No 560/2005 of 12 April 2005 ("the 2005 Regulation") implements Resolution 1572 (2004) in the European Union. Annex I to the 2005 Regulation lists the names of those designated by the UN Sanctions Committee.

Council Regulation (EU) No 25/2011

- 3. On 14 January 2011 the Council of the European Union adopted Council Regulation (EU) No 25/2011 which amends the 2005 Regulation and, amongst other matters, places certain restrictions, including an asset freeze, on persons, entities or bodies who are obstructing the process of peace and national reconciliation, and in particular who are jeopardising the proper outcome of the electoral process in the Ivory Coast, and natural or legal persons, entities or bodies associated with them. References to the provisions of the 2005 Regulation in the following paragraphs of this Notice are references to such provisions as replaced or amended by Regulation 25/2011.
- 4. The text set out in Annex I to Regulation 25/2011 is inserted into the 2005 Regulation as Annex IA and lists the persons, entities or bodies that have been designated by the Council and are therefore subject to the freezing of funds and economic resources provisions imposed under Article 2 of the 2005 Regulation. Such persons, entities or bodies are

- "designated persons" for the purposes of this Notice. The designated persons in Annex IA to the 2005 Regulation are not listed by the UN Security Council or the Sanctions Committee.
- 5. Regulation 25/2011 was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L11, 15.1.2011, P.1) on 15 January 2011. Regulation 25/2011 entered into force on 15 January 2011 and is directly applicable in the UK.

Freezing of funds and economic resources of designated persons

- 8. Article 2 of the 2005 Regulation provides that all funds and economic resources belonging to, owned, held or controlled by the persons listed in Annexes I and IA to the 2005 Regulation must be frozen.
- 9. No funds or economic resources shall be made available, directly or indirectly, to or for the benefit of designated persons.
- 10. The participation, knowingly and intentionally, in activities the object or effect of which is, directly or indirectly, to circumvent these measures is prohibited.
- 11. Annex I to the 2005 Regulation lists the natural or legal persons, entities or bodies who have been identified by the UN as being designated persons.
- 12. Annex IA to the 2005 Regulation lists the natural or legal persons, entities or bodies who have been identified by the Council of the European Union as being designated persons.
- 13. For convenience, the names of the designated persons included in the new Annex IA are set out in the Annex to this Notice.
- 14. The UK's Consolidated List of individuals and entities subject to financial sanctions in effect in the UK which is maintained on the Treasury website has been updated to include the designated persons named in Annex IA.

Frozen accounts

- 15. All funds and economic resources belonging to, owned, held or controlled by the designated persons held by banks, building societies, stockbrokers, accountants, etc must be frozen. No funds or economic resources may be made available, directly or indirectly to, or for the benefit of the designated persons unless licensed by the competent authority of a Member State in accordance with the 2005 Regulation (see paragraphs 19 and 20). The only exemptions to these prohibitions are those permitted under the 2005 Regulation (see paragraphs 17 and 18).
- 16. No payment or transfer may be made from a frozen account, including to another frozen account, without prior authorisation. This includes the deduction of fees or service charges for routine holding or maintenance of frozen accounts. Loans and other forms of credit should not be made available to designated persons.

Interest, other payments and credits

- 17. The prohibitions in the 2005 Regulation do not apply to the addition to frozen accounts of interest or other earnings on those accounts, or payments due under contracts, agreements or obligations, that were concluded or arose before the date on which the person was included in Annex I or IA to the 2005 Regulation, provided that any such interest, other earnings and payments are frozen in accordance with Article 2.
- 18. The prohibition against making funds or economic resources available does not prevent financial or credit institutions in the Union from crediting frozen accounts where they receive funds transferred to the account of a designated person, provided that any additions to such accounts are also frozen. Financial or credit institutions are required to inform the Treasury of any such transactions without delay.

Licences

- 19. The Treasury are able to authorise the release of or making available of certain frozen funds or economic resources, if they have determined that the funds or economic resources concerned are:
 - (a) necessary to satisfy the basic needs of designated persons and their dependent family members, including payments for foodstuffs, rent or mortgage, medicines and medical treatment, taxes, insurance premiums, and public utility charges;
 - (b) intended exclusively for payment of reasonable professional fees and reimbursement of incurred expenses associated with the provision of legal services;

(c) intended exclusively for payment of fees or service charges for routine holding or

maintenance of frozen funds or economic resources; or

(d) necessary for extraordinary expenses.

20. The Treasury are also able to authorise the release of or making available of certain funds or

economic resources, if they have determined that the funds or economic resources

concerned are intended exclusively to satisfy claims secured by a lien or judgement

established prior to the date the person was listed in Annex I or Annex IA to the 2005

Regulation provided the lien or judgement is not for the benefit of a designated person or

contrary to public policy and provided the EU has been notified of the lien or judgement.

Reporting requirements

21. Relevant institutions and other persons are requested to check whether they maintain any

accounts or otherwise hold any funds or economic resources for the designated persons and,

if so, they must freeze such accounts or other funds and, unless licensed by the Treasury,

refrain from making available funds and/or economic resources to designated persons.

22. Relevant institutions must report their findings to the Treasury, together with any additional

information that would facilitate compliance with the 2005 Regulation.
